A Triumph for Kerala: Sri. Joseph Palackal's elevation as Vice President FSBIPA:

A moment of profound pride resonates across the Kerala State SBI Pensioners and Retirees' Association with the electoral triumph of Sri. Joseph Palackal. Securing 46 out of 78 votes in a closely contested poll, his elevation to the post of Vice President of FSBIPA with the second-highest majority is a testament to his enduring commitment.

Sri. Palackal's record is not one of fleeting duty, but a continuum of tireless advocacy. A committed veteran, his service days saw him assume the weighty role of Deputy General Secretary of the State Banks' Staff Union.

Following his retirement in December 2012, his dedication remained unwithered; he continued to serve as Deputy General Secretary of our Association from 13th May 2013 until his recent elevation as Vice President

Editorial

SENIOR CITIZENS HEALTH AND PROSPERITY

Good health for senior citizens is crucial for maintaining independence, quality of life, and longevity. As our body ages, proactive management of lifestyle, medical care, and social connections becomes essential.

Maintaining good health in older age relies on a holistic approach that focuses on the following key areas:

Physical Activity and Mobility

Regular movement/ exercise is arguably the single most important factor for healthy ageing. It helps to (a) maintain strength and bone density (reduces the risk of osteoporosis and muscle loss – sarcopenia) (b) improve balance and coordination (essential for preventing falls, which are a leading cause of injury in older adults.) (c) boost cardiovascular health (lowers the risk of heart disease, stroke, and high blood pressure).

Recommendations: (a) aim for at least 150 minutes of moderate-intensity aerobic activity per week (like brisk walking or swimming). Ideally complete at least 4,000 steps before noon and aim for 8,000 steps by bedtime for optimal daily activity (for senior citizens only). A smart watch can motivate you. (b) include muscle-strengthening activities (using weights, resistance bands, or body weight) at least two days a week. (c) incorporating balance and flexibility exercises like Tai Chi or yoga provides added advantage. Avoid long hours of sitting; stand up and move every 45–60 minutes.

Nutrition and Diet:

Dietary needs change with age. Seniors often require fewer calories but need more nutrient-dense foods. (a) Focus on fibre. Consume whole grains, fruits, and vegetables to aid digestion and prevent constipation. (b) Ensure adequate protein. It is essential for maintaining muscle mass. (c) Prioritise calcium and vitamin D which are critical for bone health. Talk to your doctor about supplements if intake is low. (d) Stay hydrated. The sense of thirst can diminish with age. So drinking water regularly is vital to prevent dehydration. (e) Limit processed foods, excessive salt, sugar, and saturated fats.

Medical Management and Preventive Care

A diligent relationship with healthcare providers is nonnegotiable for older adults. (a) Regular Check-ups -Maintain a consistent schedule for physical exams and necessary health screenings (e.g., for cancer, blood pressure, cholesterol). (b) Vaccinations: Stay up-to-date on vaccines, especially the flu shot, pneumonia vaccine, and Shingles vaccine. (c) Medication Management - Many seniors take multiple medications. Maintain an upto-date list and review it regularly with a doctor to avoid harmful drug interactions. (d) Eye and Dental Care: Regular visits are necessary to manage issues like cataracts, glaucoma, hearing loss, and oral health problems.

Common health issues in seniors:

Older adults are at higher risk for chronic conditions, including (a) Chronic diseases: Heart disease, type 2 diabetes, stroke, and arthritis (joint pain and stiffness). (b) Cognitive decline: Issues related to memory and thinking, ranging from mild cognitive impairment to dementia (including Alzheimer's disease). (c) Mental Health: Depression and social isolation are common and often under-diagnosed. (d) Accidental Injuries: Falls are a major concern, often leading to fractures. (e) Infections: Increased vulnerability to severe illness from infections like the flu and pneumonia.

Mental and social well-being:

Mental health is just as important as physical health in old age. (a) Stay Mentally Active: Engage in activities that stimulate the brain, such as reading, puzzles, learning new skills, music / singing or playing an Maintain social connections: instrument. (b) Loneliness and social isolation are linked to poorer physical and cognitive health. Regularly interacting with family, friends, and community groups (like clubs or volunteering) is critical. (c) Get quality sleep: Aim for seven to eight hours of sleep per night. Poor sleep affects memory and overall health. (d) Manage Stress: Practice relaxation techniques like meditation or deep breathing. Stay away from people who give you stress and negative vibes. Avoid all kind of stress. (d) Engage in social media such as face-book, Instagram, YouTube etc. Also enjoy TV programmes on topics of interest. You can also watch important domestic and world places which are available on Smart TV etc. But all these screen time should be in moderation. Excessive use can harm attention span, sleep quality, and physical activity levels. Limit continuous sitting before screens to less than 1 hour at a time. Instead, balance screen time with outdoor walks, face-to-face conversations, and hobbies. (f) Read newspaper, periodicals, magazines, books on topics of interest etc. Various studies revealed that reading daily (not continuous and without affecting active life) reduce the possibility of memory loss and Alzheimer's disease among the aged. (g) wherever possible, participating in conducted tours (involving movement and active daily life) to domestic and international destinations with family, friends and relatives will improve mental health besides promote longevity.

While these habits greatly improve health and reduce the risk of lifestyle-related diseases, they do not guarantee freedom from all illnesses. Genetics, past lifestyle, metabolic factors, and many other health variables also play a role. What these practices do is tilt the balance in your favour and help you stay stronger, healthier, and more resilient as you age.

Our aspirations and FSBIPA's new responsibilities

As the sole representative of SBI pensioners, the FSBIPA has historically stood on the forefront of welfare, securing landmark concessions for more than two and a half lakh members. The recent introduction of the SBI Tribute Scheme, the cessation of commutation recovery from family pensioners, and the continuation of full pension entitlements are powerful markers of the leadership's dedication.

Yet, we acknowledge that no benevolent concession is freely given; it is the frequent pressure and strategic intervention of committed leadership that compels management to act. While our leaders have proven their strength in resolving many concerns, the horizon still holds unresolved issues demanding urgent attention. Foremost among these, is the protracted struggle over the Basic Pension 40-50 formula and the retrospective application of the 50% pension benefit, the latter lacking effect from March 1st, 1999. All eyes are now turned toward the judiciary; the crucial court case, though postponed to November 18th 2025, carries the promise of justice. As communicated by Sri. Nadaf, General Secretary FSBIPA on September 27th, 2025, a positive judgment would be a monumental victory for all those members unjustly deprived of the 50% formula from 01.03.1999 on wards.



We stand in full assurance that the commitment and vigour of the new FSBIPA leadership will continue to bring laurels, glory, and much-deserved accolades to the pensioners of the State Bank of India.

SBI Tribute: A Gesture of Compassion and Respect

On 23rd July 2025, the State Bank of India officially launched SBI TRIBUTE, a heartfelt initiative aimed at honouring the memory of its deceased pensioners by extending a compassionate hand to their families during moments of profound loss. More than a financial gesture, this scheme seeks to institutionalise an empathetic response mechanism that upholds the Bank's deep commitment to the well-being of those who once served it with dedication.

Under this initiative, an ex-gratia amount of ₹30,000 is extended to the next of kin of the deceased pensioner, accompanied by personal outreach. Within 72 hours of the sad demise, the Branch Manager, together with office bearers of the Pensioners' Association, visits the bereaved family to personally deliver the assistance and offer emotional solace, ensuring the family feels supported, seen, and respected.

On the very next day (i.e., 24th July 2025), Kerala witnessed its first such compassionate outreach when a retired SBI pensioner from Thiruvananthapuram sadly passed away. In keeping with the spirit of SBI TRIBUTE, the Branch Manager of Vanchiyoor Branch, along with **SBIPRA** representatives of the Kerala. Thiruvananthapuram District Centre, visited the bereaved home. A cheque for ₹30,000 was solemnly handed over to the grieving husband, along with a condolence message from the Regional Manager of SBI at Thiruvananthapuram.

Though it was not a moment of joy, the quiet dignity and timely response exemplified the humane values that SBI upholds, standing beside its pensioners and their families not just in service, but also in sorrow.

SBI TRIBUTE is more than a policy. It is a heartfelt promise that no family of SBI pensioners will be left alone in their moment of grief.

In the opening remarks, Sri Suseel Kumar, General Manager NW1 again welcomed the participants and informed that whatever to be delivered from the Bank side, will be done without any delay. GM also told that our Chairman is very firm that our pensioners should feel that they are important and part of the Bank. CGM in his speech told that he was delighted to be a participant in the half yearly Structured Meeting where Bank can listen to the views/ aspirations/ requirements of the pensioners. CGM informed that basically Bank is the beneficiary of the legacy. Bank is taking more care of its pensioners by introducing various incentives compared to the Govt organisations. CGM requested us to provide business leads to the Bank. CGM informed that Bank is

willing to improve further on the basis of brickbats. CGM has also requested us to support collectively and build a strong SBI.

President Sri. Radhakrishnan Pullancheri informed that SBIPRA is grateful and acknowledged the timely conduct of the Structured Meetings at LHO / AO level and most of the issues raised are resolved to our satisfaction. Some of the issues are prolonged and a few issues are figuring in the current meeting. President also assured support for the business growth of the Bank and informed that dispensary is not providing most of the formulations which is one of the main concern of the pensioners.

General Secretary Sri. Philip Koshy in his speech, thanked our great organisation – the SBI - and Chairman for increasing the family pension / stopping deduction of commutation portion from family pension and for introducing the SBI TRIBUTE. General Secretary requested the PPG Dept to inform us the visit by the Bank to the pensioners family of our non-members also, in case of death so that SBI PRA officials can also accompany them. Regarding Holiday Homes, GS suggested to reopen the Holiday Homes which were closed and to increase the rooms which were reduced during COVID Period. He also added that even though the Guruvayoor Holiday home is very close to the railway station, our pensioners are finding it difficult to go to the temple during odd hours as no conveyance like autorickshaw is available at such odd hours. Earlier there were three holiday homes in Guruvayoor and requested for one more Holiday Home near the East Nada of Guruvayoor temple. GS conveyed Association's big salute to the PPG Dept especially for the disbursement of family pension arrears. GS also suggested that dispensary can provide three months' medicines together to super senior citizens / who are coming from far off places.

Sri. Joseph Palackal, Vice President informed that the Scheme "Oppam" is having teething problems and should be sorted out soon, eventhough it is a very good initiative.

Sri. A. Raghavan, DGS said that the data pertaining to Mutual Welfare Scheme is yet to be computerised and it is difficult to know who are the members in MWS. He also suggested that the life certificate obtained for the MWS should be accepted for the regular Pension Scheme as well, thereby avoiding the need to submit two separate life certificates.



Discussion on the Agenda items included (a) Inclusion of differently abled children in HRMS for family pension eligibility – Of the total 47 cases, 17 were approved, one rejected and remaining 29 under process (b) Increase in working hours of doctors – Alappuzha approved, Ernakulam, Kannur, Kottayam and Palakkad under (c) Rejection of Ayurveda Bills – the relaed bills will be scrutinised by our approved doctor at Medicine supply as per Thiruvananthapuram (d) stocking pattern prescribed by Corporate Center - 251 drugs included (e) Family pension revision based on last drawn pay - Out of 110 cases 95 cases completed. Remaining under process. (f) HRMS facilities to CPF optees - under consideration of the Corporate center. (g) Data of MWS - will be updated soon with the support of Association. (h) Revised PPO to pensioners – will be completed at the earliest. (i) Increase of rooms at Holiday Homes – will be considered.

After the discussions, Vote of Thanks was proposed by Sri. Joseph Palakal, VP. He thanked the CGM, GMs and

others from the Management side and suggested to conduct Pensioners' Meet in all AOs prior to the LHO meeting.



The Meeting ended at 4.30 pm.

Members are reminded that the current Health Insurance Policy B remains valid only up to 15th January 2026. Renewal will take effect from 16th January 2026. Policy B renewal period will begin on 1st January 2026 and normally close on 15th January 2026.

Members are requested to log in to their HRMS portal (preferably through a computer or laptop) and verify all details relating to self, spouse, and differently abled child/children (if any). If any discrepancy is noticed, please correct it at the earliest through your Pension Paying Branch. Do not wait for the last moment.

Ensure your Name, DOB, address, mobile number, email, pension paying branch details, Aadhaar and PAN details etc are correctly recorded in HRMS. Also ensure your joint photo is available.

Please ensure that the renewal is completed well in time to avoid any last minute rush. Online mode is strongly recommended for convenience and smooth processing. Also, Bank may insist on online mode only. Bank is expected to issue an eCircular on renewal of Policy B before the last week of December 2025.

Act early and ensure uninterrupted coverage for you and your dependent.

Submit Your Life Certificate in November 2025 itself

All pensioners are requested to submit their Life Certificate during the month of November 2025. Please do not wait till the last minute.

The Video Life Certificate (VLC) is the most convenient and recommended method. For this, you must use the HRMS Mobile App, not the HRMS portal on your computer. Every year, the Bank introduces technical updates to the system, and minor glitches may occur initially. These are usually resolved within a few days, after which submission becomes smooth and effortless. You can complete it from home or anywhere in the world. It is reliably learnt that, from this year onwards, family pensioners can also submit VLC after updating HRMS.

If you face any difficulty, you may visit your pension paying branch and submit the manual Life Certificate. **Important**: After submission, please verify that the validity of the certificate is updated up to 31.10.2026.

Act early and ensure your pension remains uninterrupted!

A cyber fraud incident

A pensioner in Palakkad fell victim to a credit card offer scam by fraudsters posing as PNB officials. A fraudulent app was installed on the phone, allowing hackers to access OTPs and make unauthorized transactions, even without the OTPs being shared..

The first thing to realise is that the mobile phone is now compromised. Switch off mobile data / Wi-Fi immediately. This will disconnect the fraudster for the time being. From a computer, log in to Internet Banking (INB) and check if the password is intact. Through INB, disable the CNP channel of all debit cards. Note the unauthorized transaction details and report them with transaction details and ID proof to the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (www.cybercrime.gov.in). If can't use a computer, call cyber fraud helpline 1930. **Speed is crucial**. Police also will report in the same site only.

As the phone is compromised, after reporting to the portal, do a factory reset of the mobile phone to remove the malicious /aggressive screen share app. Now it is safe to switch on mobile data/ WiFi and then reinstall only trusted apps. Also, install a full fledged antivirus app.

Emotional resonances of a well-wisher

SBI Pensioners' Association Kerala now rechristened as SBI Pensioners and Reirees' Association Kerala, has once again recorded its undisputed position at national level with Sri Joseph Palackal getting elected as one of the Vice Presidents of the Federation. I am aware that, long back, SBIPA Kerala had the opportunity of getting our then President Sri Manjila Raphael nominated as the Federation Vice President of South Zone (Hyderabad, Chennai, Karnataka and Kerala). But Sri Joseph Palackal's victory in the Federation's triennial election held on 25th August 2025 in Raipur, definitely is distinctive and stands out for the reason that he got elected in an election process, securing more than 60 percent of the total votes polled. He secured 46 votes and retained the second position among the winners.

Sri Joseph Palackal popularly known among his friends and colleagues as "Palackan", as I know him very closely for the last more than 13 years, is a seasoned, dynamic leader of SBI Pensioners and Retirees' Association Kerala whose contribution to the unprecedented growth of the Association is incomparable. I recall our working together in the Association leadership after getting elected as Vice President and Dy General Secretary respectively in SBIPA Annual General Meeting held in 2013 at Kottayam. Then onwards, through our combined efforts, we could bring a total revamp of the organisational activities of our Association. The growth and development of any association, as all of you agree, is fully dependent on its membership strength. Unfortunately for a long period this important aspect was given either less attention or priority in our SBIPA. Having had the experience as leaders of the serving Officers' association and Staff union, we insisted for streamlining the functioning of EC in particular and the organisation in general. It was indeed an effective turnaround thereafter that one could observe visible changes in the functioning. The EC meetings which were routinely held for less than three hours and concluded before lunch were transformed into full day meetings with threadbare discussions on each and every agenda item. This was indeed a welcoming change in the overall functioning of the Association that led SBIPA to reach in its present esteemed position.

The membership drive now being effectively implemented in all districts, I must say, is at the instance of Sri Palackan who meticulously provided the list of prospective retirees in all districts every month and insisted each districts to get the membership of all. His personal follow up with District Secretaries could bring out excellent results in his regard. The unprecedented growth in membership of our Association since 2014 is definitely due to such an initiative, no doubt.

As the DGS of Ernakulam district, his contributions are many. There are so many achievements brought into the Association, more particularly in Ernakulam District as DGS. Attaining for the first time, the magical number of 1000 in the Ernakulam District membership, bringing out a beautiful multicoloured Directory for Ernakulam district in 2019, successful introduction and implementation of standing instruction scheme for sustainable financial position not only in Ernakulam district, but in other districts also, prompt scheduling and meticulous arrangements for quarterly EC meetings etc., are a few examples of the visionary in him.

As the Chief Editor of our quarterly bulletin I must specially thank him for the dedicated services he rendered for the timely publication of our Bulletin. The long hours he spent with Ajayan of Peringat Printers for getting the best result in the layout of each bulletin and its timely dispatch through Ernakulam Business post office is always gratefully remembered.

It will be unfair if I conclude this without mentioning how Sri Joseph Palackal earned the respectable and coveted position in the Federation. What I feel is, his entry into the Federation as GB member from Kerala, was indeed a predestined one. I could observe and feel the calibre on his very first appearance in the Federation GB meeting. 
