The Governing Body and Annual General Meeting of our Federation was held on 30th and 31st March 2016 at State Bank Learning Centre, Patna. The meeting was inaugurated by Shri. B S Negi General Manager Network III LHO Patna in presence of more than 75 delegates who have come from all parts of the country representing the various affiliates." It is a special privilege to be among the fraternity of the senior most citizens of our Bank who had contributed much to the growth and development of our Bank." He

continued. Shri. R N Banerjee, President of our Federation while delivering his presidential address welcomed all the senior colleagues and paid rich compliments to the host affiliate for the excellent arrangements made for the meeting. During our service we have all contributed much to our Bank. However today we are confronted with many issues. The pension fund corpus is more than 64000 crores. But when it comes to the issue of revision of pension and also rectification of anomalies in

respect of 7th bipartite retirees, sluggishness is observed often on the part of both Government and Bank. He hoped that the issues will be deliberated in detail in the business session. Before concluding his address he also thanked the Circle Management for providing the very spacious conference hall in the new SBLC. While extending his felicitations Shri. VijaykantPatak Circle Development Officer, Patna LHO, expressed his pleasure in attending the meeting and also assured all the support to the Pensioners Association. "It is not a fight of yours alone. Tomorrow when we retire it becomes our issue also and hence we will be with you all." He concluded.

Shri.GhanashyamSrivastava General Secretary of SBI Officers Association Patna Circle, who spoke on the occasion paid respects to all the senior leaders who played a bigger role in the serving Associations prior to their retirement. He offered all the support of his organisation in solving our issues. Shri. A. Ramesh Babu, General Secretary of our Federation recalled the previous three General Body meetings held in Patna and felt happy that this 31st Annual General meeting is also being held in Patna again. He gave a detailed account

of the plight of pensioners in our Bank. "We have been fighting for the past 20 years. The case we filed in Supreme Court and subsequently transferred to Delhi High Court in 2013 is still being heard almost every week with no result at all. The Central Govt. Employees get an increase of 50% in their salary revision whereas in the salary revision of Bank employees Government puts all resistance. He vehemently condemned the attitude of the Government and concluded that a long drawn fight alone can solve our problems.

The Chief General Manager of Patna Circle Shri.AjitSood, who joined the meeting in the afternoonbegan his felicitations saying that he always made it a point not to miss the opportunity of meeting the elders and seniors of the Bank. He could not be present in the morning for being preoccupied with a meeting with the Chief Minister. He spoke on the new medical insurance scheme introduced in our Bank for the benefit of Retirees. He also touched upon the latest challenges faced by the

Bank. He concluded recalling the yeoman services rendered by all the seniors. The others who spoke on the occasion included S.ShriP.K.Mitra (DMD Retd) AC Varma (DMD Retd) AP Varma (DMD Retd) Ashok Mukund (DMD Retd) Shivaji Singh (Former GS of SBIOA) JN Singh (former GS of Staff Association) ShantaRaju(Vice President, Federation) and S.Saravanamuthu (General Secretary Pensioners Association Chennai.

National Anthem

Attention Members/Readers

We are happy to inform that at the request of our Federation Bank has extended the date of joining Group Mediclaim Policy 'B' till 30-04-2016. Necessary instructions in this regard have been issued vide e-Circular P&HRD. Sl. No.: 17/2016 - 17 Circular No.: CDO/P&HRD-PPFG/1/2016-17 April 02,2016. Members who are yet to join the scheme may submit their applications before 30-4-2016.

It should also be noted that as per IRDA regulations members of the scheme has to submit duly filled in Mandate form for Electronic clearing System attaching a cancelled cheque of their account while submitting their FIRST CLAIM for reimbursement

and the inordinate delay suffered on account of the indifferent approach of all concerned. The meeting felt that a concerted follow up action has to be made by reconstituting the legal monitoring committee. The meeting decided to reconstitute the existing committee by including members from Delhi Chennai, Karnataka, Bhopal and Kerala along with President and General Secretary of the Federation. The meeting concluded at 6 pm.

The Annual General Meeting began at 10 am on 31st March. In his presidential address Shri. RN Banerjee explained in detail the latest in our WP 1875 and its latest postponement to 26th April at the request of ASG. There was strong resentment against the lacklustre approach from all including Bank and Government and the members urged upon the leadership to adopt any action which would bring a speedy and logical conclusion. From our

Association S.Shri John Joseph, Antony D'couto, K.Rajeevan V. Karunakaran and Joseph Palackal participated in the discussions.

The meeting thereafter unanimously nominated Shri, A. Ramesh Babu as the General Secretaryand Shri.Dipak Kumar Basu as the secretary of the Federation for the remaining term. General Secretary's report and the financial statements were thereafter presented and was approved after detailed discussions. The meeting deliberated on the issue of augmentation of Legal fund and it was decided to collect pro rata amount from each affiliate. Regarding amendments to the bye-laws the meeting decided to constitute a committee to look into the same within three months and all the affiliates were requested to submit their proposals within a month. The meeting concluded at 5.30 pm after national anthem.

EDITORIAL

All eyes now set to Kollam. Elaborate preparations are being made by the organising committee for the historic conference of 15th Annual General Body meeting of SBI Pensioners Association Kerala to be held on 29th May 2016 at the CSI Hall Kollam. The previous meeting held on 31st May 2015 at Kozhikode had set a new record for its large attendance of more than 350 members who has come there from all parts of the state. There has been a phenomenal increase in the membership since then due to the massive retirements taken place during the year. Kollam conference is definitely going to be another historic one and the onus of making it a reality lies on all of us. The Annual General Body Meetings of all District units have been completed and the new team of leadership at District centres have come into force

effective from 1st April 2016. The names of Presidents and Secretaries of all district units and names of delegates elected from the districts are published in this bulletin. Kollam conference will also signify for another remarkable step in our organisational activity. Unlike in the past we are introducing the new electoral system to decide on the leadership for the forthcoming triennial period 2016-2019, strictly adhering to the democratic principles, the details of which are included in this issue. We request all our members to go through the instructions very closely and also to start preparations for being a part of the historic meeting.

Much was expected in the central budget for the year 2016-2017 especially in favour of senior citizens and Retirees like us. Increasing the IT exemption limit from present 3 lacs to 5 lacs was more prominent and widely propagated. However, the FM did not heed to any such yearnings of the hapless millions. Adding insult to injury FM chose for a reduction in interest rates in small savings schemes like PPF, NSC etc. which is mostly subscribed by Pensioners and salaried income groups. In short life becomes more and more miserable with the new policies of the Govt. and our hopes and aspirations for a brighter day are becoming thin and narrow.

Well friends, amidst these sorrows and worries we were fortunate that our Bank has introduced two mediclaim insurance policies exclusively for the retirees of the Bank. The scheme is indeed a relief for those who were not the members of SBIREMBS and who could not join the scheme for various reasons and especially the family pensioners. Compared to many other medical insurance scheme the

scheme opened by our Bank is no doubt with many advantages. Though the acceptance in the initial period was not that much encouraging, may be due to the lack of awareness and publicity, the scheme has picked up wide acceptance numbering more than forty thousand under Policy 'B' alone. Still there are many remaining to join the scheme. On a request from our Federation we are happy to inform our members that Bank has extended the last date for joining till 30th April 2016. We are hopeful that all our members shall utilise the opportunity and that nobody is deprived of the benefits.

UPDATE ON OUR WP 1875/2013 IN DELHI HIGH COURT

Members are informed that the above case came up for hearing on 28th March. It is reported that the counsel for the Government of India sought time to respond submitting that the committee set up by Government of India would meet on 29th March 2016. Despite objection raised by our Advocates and the Court's observation that delaying the matter was not desirable the case has been adjourned and an order was passed by the Hon'ble Court posting the case for further hearing on 26th April 2016.

The Prominent Agenda items came up for discussions included:

Improvements in facilities provided to pensioners in Medical Dispensaries,

Uploading of Life certificates and difficulties suffered by many members.

Online submission of applications for terminal benefits

Delay in sanction and release of Family Pension.

Extending of Goodwill package to all pensioners every year

Sanction of pension on revised salary in respect of 7th bipartite retirees.

Removal of anomalies in pension in respect of 5th and 6thBipartite retirees.

Introduction of Grievance cell for pensioners in LHOs.

Higher percentage of pension for senior pensioners above the age of 75 years.

Uniform Dearness Relief for all pensioners irrespective of date of retirement, with change at quarterly intervals.

The meeting was held in a very cordial atmosphere wherein the management assured to consider the issues well within their powers.
