# Editorial

#### PENSION UPDATION – IS IT A FAR DISTANT DREAM?

"I want bank employees to be given their due. A lot of pensioners are waiting for a very long time. Yesterday, I had meeting with Rajkiran Rai of IBA. I spoke to him, too. We need bank employees to be attended to particularly their families and the pension of retired employees." - Mrs. Nirmala Sitharaman, Finance Minister, Government of India.

More than five lacs of Bank pensioners across the country breathed a sigh of relief when they listened to the Hon'ble Union Finance Minister while sharing the above information with the print and visual media, on the eve of the Annual General Meeting of Indian Banks Association on 10th November 2020 in Mumbai. It was the pronouncement by the most competent authority admitting the pitiable situation in which the hapless Bank pensioners are placed, struggling for their survival and existence. Many among the public refused to believe that the pension amount drawn by a bank pensioner remained static till his/her final exit from the world. They are under the impression that what is prevalent in Central and State Government services, where pension amount also gets revised correspondingly with each salary revision as per the pay commission recommendations, is applicable to Bank pensioners also. Whereas in Banking Sector it continues as an all-time anomaly that when the salary revision settlement takes place every five years it does not provide for a revision in pension of the

existing pensioners. Six bipartite settlements have so far taken place ever since the pension scheme was introduced in Banking Sector. But quite unfortunately there was not even a passing reference about the revision in pension in any one of these settlements. Obviously, those who retired under the sixth bipartite are continuing with the same pension even after a lapse of twenty-five years. Similar is the position of others who retired thereafter under the respective bipartite settlement they belonged to. Whatever was the pension fixed for them based on their last drawn basic salary did not undergo any revision thereafter. Delegations, resolutions and representations initiated by individual pensioners and various organisations of retirees and pensioners throughout the country and placed before the Government and Bank Managements did not evoke any positive response so far. On the contrary, the management came out with the oft repeated reason of requiring additional financial provision which is far from true. The satisfactory position in pension corpus funds, held by different Banks as revealed in the financial statements obtained under Right to Information disproved the argument of IBA and Government in that regard. It has also been ascertained that the inflow to the pension corpus by way of interest earned, vield on investments and Bank's contribution each year is more than what is actually paid out as pension. It is pertinent to make a mention of the New Pension Scheme which was introduced in the year 2010, which proclaims the winding up of the prevailing pension scheme after a certain point of time. Quite obviously the pension corpus fund also will become redundant thereafter. Facts being so, we are unable to understand why Bank pensioners of our country are deprived of their well-deserved eligibility for the past three decades. It is also not clear how the actuaries have worked out the requirements of provision towards pension payment.

It is almost one and a half year after the Hon'ble Finance Minister directed the Chairmen of IBA and SBI to look into the pension updation issue of Bank Pensioners in the country. Thousands of our pensioner brethren who heaved euphoric sighs of relief after listening to press meet of Madam Finance Minister on 11 th November 2020 have already left for their heavenly abode. We also heard about the formation of a small committee by IBA to report on the feasibility of the much-debated pension updation. Unfortunately, nothing heard about the Committee's dealings thereafter. We feel that time has come now, for placing the one and only question before the respected authorities in IBA and DFS, are we, the poor old and hapless, to continue building hopes on this receding star? Is Updation of Pension a far distant dream?

#### Tail Piece

The Civil Appeal No. 6727 of 2018 filed before the Hon'ble Supreme court of India in respect of payment of gratuity enhanced from Rs.3.50 lacs to Rs.10 lacs to all those who retired after 01/01/2006 came up for final hearing on 24 th February 2022. The Hon'ble Court refused to interfere with the matter and dismissed the captioned Civil Appeal opining that the fixing of the cut of date for disbursing the enhanced gratuity is the discretion of employer as rightly, concurrently and consistently upheld by the Hon'ble High Court.

#### **MORE ON FAMILY PENSION ANOMALIES**

In our Bulletin volume 9, Issue 8 (July–Sept 2021), I had penned an article regarding Family Pension of Bank employees. The article was a hurriedly prepared one after the announcement of enhancement of family pension from 15 % to 30 % without any upper ceiling. In that article what I tried to highlight was the plight of the lowest paid family pensioners in Banks, who are already getting 30% of the last drawn pay of the pensioner. Though they were the lowest paid among all pensioners, there is not even a single rupee increase in pension, whereas better paid family pensioners, especially who retired from the higher posts got varying increase in pension starting from 100 % to more than 300 % increase. That article was meant to invite the attention of those who formulated the revised pension to the plight of the lowest paid family pensioners. However, there was no response of any kind from those who are in the helm of affairs and the plight of the most deserving among family pensioners were totally neglected. The most heart-breaking part of the case is there was no protest from any of the all-India pensioners associations or working unions, as they seem to think this is either a trivial issue or no issue at all.

My article was circulated in several other state pensioners' forum through Whatsapp etc. on account of the efforts by our Pensioners Association State President Mr. K Rajeevan, and the response I received from several pensioners all over India, thanking me for highlighting the issue of Lowest paid family pensioners as well as getting their pension / family pension verified by me. This only prompted me to write another article on Family pension highlighting the grave areas to be noticed by Bank Pensioners after the revision in Family pension without any upper ceiling.

#### 1. PENSIONERS RETIRED BEFORE 01.11.2002

These are family pensioners who are the worst affected. Earlier their pension was sanctioned as per the scale of pay drawn in their previous wage settlement. After years long untiring efforts by all, they were sanctioned revision of their pension as per the actual pay drawn by them. Accordingly, bank revised their pension and also revised family pension of such employees. However, the bank did not inform such pensioners / family pensioners about their pension revision and payment was only affected. This has brought a situation, where pensioners do not have any record to claim their eligible family pension, whenever they found there are anomalies in the revised pension.

In our circle, several pensioners were complaining that though their family pension was expected to double (when enhanced from 15 to 30%) what they were currently getting, but received only an increase of 20 to 25% in pension. On a close scrutiny of such pensioners, I had noticed that the lower increase in pension was mainly on account of erroneous calculation taking original family pension sanctioned to them instead of revised family pension described above.

Majority of these family pensioners are more than 75 years old and unaware of revision of their family pension. Only a very small percentage of family pensioners know about the family pension revision and aware that their revised pension seems short of their entitlement. Majority of the family pensioners, who are getting a total pension of Rs. 6000 to 17500 are very happy to receive a pension increase of even an amount of Rs. 1500 Rs. 4000 though they are entitled to get their pension amount doubled, which they are actually unaware. Pensioners Associations should take an active interest to see that all family pensioners get their eligible revised family pension, without being troubled to send individual representations for rectifying the anomalies. This category of pensioners, as I stated above are very old aged and we have to see that they are paid the eligible family pension at the earliest. There are clear Corporate Centre guidelines to the circles to revise the pension/family pension, whenever there is a change in the pension calculation on account of wage revision/corrections in their substantive pay, without getting a request of the pensioner. However, authorities concerned are either unaware of such instructions or pretend there are no such instructions.

# 2. PENSIONERS WHO RETIRED AFTER COMMENCEMENT OF NEXT BIPARTITE SETTLEMENT PERIOD BUT BEFORE SIGNING THE AGREEMENT

There will always be several pensioners who falls under the above category. After settlement of the wage revision, such pensioners were paid arrears of salary and also got their pension revised. However, a majority of the pensioners did not get their revised Pension Payment Order incorporating the revised substantive pay. Though they were getting revised pension, they are unable to verify the correctness of their pension / family pension. Another common error observed in such cases who received revised P P O is the error in family pension, which in many cases were not corrected / revised.

Now the question comes how we safeguard the interest of the pensioners. The first and foremost is getting a communication, whenever there is any change in the existing pension. But how far it will be effective, we have to wait and see. Moreover after the death of the pensioner, spouse or children are not aware of their entitlement of family pension and hence even when they receive lower amount of pension, the same is not getting proper attention. Under these circumstances, I make an earnest attempt to make the pensioners get an idea about how much Family Pension their dear ones get after their demise. If the pensioners give an idea about the approximate amount of family pension, they are entitled, to their spouse / children, it will go a long way to bring to the attention of the family members if any errors are crept into. Many aged pensioners also requested me to inform them their eligible family pension so that they have peace of mind to know how much their family will get in their absence. For such pensioners also this article will give an idea of how much is their family pension entitlement.

#### Points to be noted.

- 1. Basic Pension in the maximum scale without PQA, FPA and Spl. Allowance is taken.
- 2. For award staff and Officers under JMG I Category, Family pension will be always 60% of the last drawn pension except a few in the last Bipartite settlement, who is drawing a Special allowance of Rs.11000. Also those retired before 31.10.2002, there will be higher increase in 60% on account of DA without 100% neutralization. (60% to 88.31%) This is because lower amount of basic family pension carry higher % of DA.
- 3. Officers above JMG I category, Basic Pension is 40 % of the average last drawn Basic Pay of 12 months. For these officers' family pension shall be slightly more than the 60% as shown in the table above. When FPA and PQA if available, family pension percentage will be marginally lower than the amount shown in the table.
- 4. These Table is applicable only for employees who were eligible for full pension with more than 30 years pensionable service.
- 5. Those employees who had lower pensionable service (less than 30 years), and are drawing less than the maximum eligible pension, Family pension will be more than 60%. For example, an employee eligible for pension with 18 years or lesser service, their eligible family pension will be equal to the pension drawn by the retired employee.

- 6. Those employees who had passed away before attaining superannuation or 65 years are eligible for family pension equal to the eligible full pension of the employee for first 5 years or up to 65 years of age of the retired employee, whichever is earlier. (Commutation amount will be deducted)
- 7. The above calculations are made based on the Gross Pension of the employee. Those who had commuted their pension had to add the commuted portion of the pension to their actual pension credited to their pension account.
- 8. % of family pension to that of pension received by a pensioner is higher than 60 %, not because of higher amount of family pension, but on account of the pensioner drawing lesser amount of pension on account of service less than 30 years or drawing pension less than 50% of the substantive pay.
- 9. For employees who had opted IBA pension formula, (E SBT Employees) all employees irrespective of category shall get 60% of their last drawn pay as Family Pension. Exception is in the case of employees, who had e lesser than 33 years of service, who will be getting 60 % to 100% of their last drawn pension as Family pension. Those employees who had passed away before attaining superannuation or 65 years are eligible for family pension equal to the eligible full pension of the employee or twice the eligible family pension amount, whichever is lower for first 7 years or up to 65 years of age of the retired employee, whichever is earlier. (Commutation amount will not be deducted)

The percentage shown in the table above are only indicative. But we can safely arrive at the indicative family pension eligible by applying the percentage in the table (last column of the table) with the last drawn pension of the retiree. Add commutation amount to the last drawn pension if the same is deducted from the gross pension to arrive at the indicative family pension amount. At any stage, Family pension of an employee shall not be less than 60% if not more of the last drawn pension amount credited to their pension account + Commuted pension if any.

#### ഫാമിലി പെൻഷനിലെ അപാകതകളെകുറിച്ച് കുറെക്കുടി

നമ്മുടെ സ്റ്റേറ്റ് അസോസിയേഷൻ ബുള്ളറ്റിനിൽ (വോള്വം 9 ലക്കം 8, ജൂലൈ-സെപ്റ്റംബർ 2021) ബാങ്ക് ജീവനക്കാരുടെ ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ സംബന്ധിച്ച് ഞാൻ ഒരു ലേഖനം എഴുതിയിരുന്നു. ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ പതിനഞ്ച് ശതമാനത്തിൽ നിന്ന് മുപ്പതു ശതമാനമായി വർഡിപ്പിക്കുമെന്ന പ്രഖ്യാപനം വന്നതിനു ശേഷം ഉടനെ തയ്യാറാക്കിയ ലേഖനമായിരുന്നു അത്. ആ ലേഖനതിൽ ഞാൻ എടുത്തുകാട്ടാൻ ശ്രമിച്ചത് ബാങ്കുകളിലെ ഏറ്റവും കുറഞ്ഞ ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻകാരുടെ ദുരവസ്ഥയാണ്. എല്ലാ പെൻഷൻകാരിലും ഏറ്റവും കുറഞ്ഞ വേതനം ലഭിക്കുന്നവരായിരുന്നു ഇവരെങ്കിലും പെൻഷനിൽ ഒരുരൂപ പോലും വർഡിച്ചിട്ടില്ല.

എന്നാൽ മെച്ചപ്പെട്ട പെൻഷൻ ലഭിക്കുന്ന ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻകാർക്ക് പ്രത്യേകിച്ചു ഉയർന്ന തസ്തികകളിൽ നിന്ന് വിരമിച്ചവർക്ക് പെൻഷനിൽ 100 % മുതൽ 300% ത്തിലധികം വർഡനവ് വരെ ലഭിച്ചു. ഏറ്റവും കുറഞ്ഞ വേതനം ലഭിക്കുന്ന കുടുംബ പെൻഷൻകാരുടെ ദുരവസ്ഥയിലേക്ക് പുതുക്കിയ പെൻഷൻ ആവിഷ്ക്കരിച്ചവരുടെ ശ്രദ്ധ ക്ഷണിക്കാനായിരുന്നു ആ ലേഖനം. എന്നിട്ടും അധികാര സ്ഥാനങ്ങളിൽനിന്ന് ഒരു തരത്തിലുള്ള പ്രതികരണവും ഉണ്ടാകാത്തതിനാൽ കുടുംബ പെൻഷൻകാരിൽ ഏറ്റവും അർഹരായവരുടെ ദുരിതംതീർത്തും അവഗണിക്കപ്പെട്ടു. ഇവിടെ ഏറ്റവും ഹൃദയഭേദകമായ ഭാഗം, ഓൾ ഇന്ത്വ പെൻഷനേർസ് അസ്സാസ്സിയേഷനിൽ നിന്നോ മറ്റു സഹോദര സംഘടനകളിൽ നിന്നോ കാര്യമായ യാതൊരു ഇടപെടലും ഉണ്ടായതായി കാണുന്നില്ല. കാരണം ഇത് കേവലം നിസ്സാരമായ പ്രശ്നമോ അഥവാ ഒരു പ്രശ്നമേ അല്ലെന്നു അവർക്ക് തോന്നിയിരിക്കും.

നമ്മുടെ പെൻഷനേഴ്സ് അസോസിയേഷൻ സംസ്ഥാന പ്രസിഡണ്ട് ശ്രീ കെ രാജീവന്റെ ശ്രമഫലമായി, വാട്ട്സ് ആപ്പ് വഴിയും മറ്റും പല സംസ്ഥാന പെൻഷനേഴ്സ് ഫോറത്തിലും എന്റെ ലേഖനം പ്രചരിപ്പിക്കുകയുണ്ടായി. രാജ്യത്തുടനീളമുള്ള നിരവധി പെൻഷൻകാരിൽ നിന്ന് നല്ല പ്രതികരണം ഇതിനു ലഭിച്ചു. ഏറ്റവും കുറഞ്ഞ ശമ്പളമുള്ള കുടുംബ പെൻഷൻകാരുടെ പ്രശ്നം എടുത്തുകാണിച്ചതിനും അവരിൽ ചിലരുടെ ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ ഞാൻ പരിശോധിച്ചു കൃത്വത വരുത്തിയതിനും നന്ദി അറിയിക്കുകയും ചെയ്തു. ഇതുകൊണ്ടാണ് കുടുംബ പെൻഷൻ പരിധിയില്ലാതെ പരിഷ്കരിച്ചതിനുശേഷമുള്ള ഈ കാലയളവിൽ ബാങ്ക് പെൻഷൻകാർ ശ്രദ്ധിക്കേണ്ട ഗൗരവമായ വിഷയങ്ങളെ പ്രതിപാദിച്ചുകൊണ്ടു ഫാമിലി പെൻഷനെ കുറിച്ച് മറ്റൊരു ലേഖനം എഴുതാൻ എന്നെ പ്രേരിപ്പിച്ചത്.

ഈ കാലഘട്ടത്തിൽ വിരമിച്ചവരുടെ ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻകാരാണ് ഏറ്റവും കൂടുതൽ ദുരിതമനുഭവിക്കുന്നത്. അവർക്ക് പെൻഷൻ അനുവദിച്ചിരുന്നത് തൊട്ട്മുൻപുള്ള ബൈപാർട്ടെറ്റ് സെറ്റിൽമെന്റിൽ വരുന്ന ശമ്പള സ്കെയിൽ അനുസരിച്ചായിരുന്നു. എന്നാൽ ഇവർക്ക് യഥാർത്ഥത്തിൽ ലഭിക്കേണ്ടിയിരുന്നത് അവർ വിരമിച്ചതിനുശേഷം പ്രാബല്യത്തിൽ വന്ന പുതിയ സെറ്റിൽമെന്റ് അനുസരിച്ചായിരുന്നു. വളരെ നീങ്ങ പോരാട്ടത്തിനൊടുവിൽ, പുതുക്കിയ സെറ്റിൽമെന്റ് അനുസരിച്ചുള്ള അടിസ്ഥാന ശമ്പളം കണക്കാക്കി അത്തരം ജീവനക്കാരുടെ പെൻഷനും കുടുംബ പെൻഷനും പരിഷ്കരിച്ചു. എന്നാൽ പരിഷ്കരിച്ച പെൻഷൻ സംബന്ധമായ യാതൊരു അറിയിപ്പും അവർക്ക് നൽകിയില്ല. കുടുംബപെൻഷൻ പരിഷ്കരണത്തിലെ എന്തെങ്കിലും അപാകതകൾ ഉണ്ടായിരുന്നോ എന്ന് പരിശോധിക്കാനുള്ള ഒരു രേഖയും അവരുടെ പക്കൽ ഉണ്ടായില്ല എന്നതാണ് യാഥാർത്ഥ്വം.

നമ്മുടെ സർക്കിളിൽ നിരവധി പെൻഷൻകാർ തങ്ങളുടെ ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ ഇപ്പോൾ ലഭിക്കുന്നതിന്റെ ഇരട്ടിയാകുമെന്ന് (15 ൽ നിന്ന് 30% ആയി ഉയർത്തുമ്പോൾ) പ്രതീക്ഷിച്ചിരുന്നെങ്കിലും പെൻഷനിൽ 20 മുതൽ 25% വരെ വർഡനവ് മാത്രമേ ഉണ്ടായുള്ളൂ എന്ന് പരാതിപ്പെട്ടിരുന്നു ഇത്തരം പെൻഷൻകാരുടെ പെൻഷൻ സൂക്ഷ്മമായി പരിശോധിച്ചപ്പോൾ, ഒരു കാര്വം മനസ്സിലായി പെൻഷൻ പരിഷ്കരിച്ചതിന്റെ കുഴപ്പമല്ല, മറിച്ചു ആദ്യം അനുവദിച്ച ഫാമിലിപെൻഷനിൽ കടന്നുകൂടിയ തെറ്റുകൾ കാരണമാണ് പെൻഷൻ കുറഞ്ഞതെന്ന് ബോധ്യപ്പെട്ടു. ഈ ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻകാരിൽ ഭൂരിഭാഗവും 75 വയസ്സിനു മുകളിൽ പ്രായമുള്ളവരും അവരുടെ ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ പുതുക്കിയതിനെ കുറിച്ചോ പുതുക്കുന്നതിനെക്കുറിച്ചോ അറിവില്ലാത്തവരുമാണ്. കൂടാതെ അവർക്ക് പുതുക്കികിട്ടിയ പെൻഷനാണ് യഥാർത്ഥത്തിൽ അവർക്ക് അർഹതപ്പെട്ട പെൻഷൻ എന്നതുപോലും മനസ്സിലാക്കാൻ പരിജ്ഞാനമില്ലാത്തവരാണ്. കുടുംബ പെൻഷൻകാരിൽ ഭൂരിഭാഗവും 6000 മുതൽ 17500 വരെ മൊത്തം പെൻഷൻവാങ്ങുന്നവരാണ്. 1500 മുതൽ 4000 രൂപ വർഡന പോലും ലഭിക്കുന്നതിൽ വളരെ സന്തോഷം കണ്ടെത്തുന്നവരാണ് ഇവർ. പക്ഷെ അവർക്ക് ഇതിന്റെ ഇരട്ടി പെൻഷൻ കിട്ടാൻ അർഹതയുണ്ടെങ്കിലും അതെനപ്പറ്റി ഒട്ടും ഗ്രാഹ്വമില്ല എന്നതാണ് സത്വം.

അപാകതകൾ പരിഹരിക്കുന്നതിനായി ഓരോരുത്തരും വെവ്വേറെ നിവേദനം കൊടുക്കുന്നതിനുപകരം എല്ലാ ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻകാർക്കും അർഹമായ പുതുക്കിയ ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ ലഭിക്കുന്നുണ്ടെന്ന് ഉറപ്പുവരുത്താൻ പെൻഷനേഴ്സ് അസോസിയേഷനുകൾ മുൻകൈ എടുക്കണം. ഈ വിഭാഗം പെൻഷൻകാർ, ഞാൻ നേരത്തെ സൂചിപ്പിച്ചതുപോലെ വളരെ പ്രായമായവരാണ്, അവർക്ക് അർഹതപ്പെട്ട ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ എത്രയും വേഗം ലഭിക്കുന്നുണ്ടോ എന്ന് നാം ശ്രദ്ധിക്കേണ്ടതുണ്ട്. പെൻഷൻ / ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ പരിഷ്കരിക്കുന്നതിന് സർക്കിളുകൾക്ക് വ്വക്തമായ കേന്ദ്ര മാർഗ്ഗനിർദ്ദേശങ്ങൾ ഉണ്ട്, വേതന പരിഷ്കരണത്തിന്റെ ഭാഗമായി പെൻഷനിൽ മാറ്റം വരുത്തുമ്പോഴെല്ലാം, പെൻഷൻകാരുടെ അപേക്ഷ ലഭിക്കാതെ തന്നെ പെൻഷനും കുടുംബ പെൻഷനും പുതുക്കിനൽകണം എന്നതാണ് അഭിന്റെ ചുരുക്കം. ഉത്തരവാദപ്പെട്ടവർ ഈ നിർദ്ദേശങ്ങൾ അറിയാതിരിക്കുകയോ അറിഞ്ഞില്ലെന്നു നടിക്കുകയോ ആണ് ചെയ്യുന്നത്.

#### പുതിയ ബൈപാർട്ടൈറ്റ് സെറ്റിൽമെന്റ് കാലാവധി തുടങ്ങിയ ശേഷം, എന്നാൽ കരാർ ഒപ്പിടുന്നതിന് മുമ്പ് വിരമിച്ചവർ

മേൽപ്പറഞ്ഞ വിഭാഗത്തിൽ പെടുന്ന നിരവധി പെൻഷൻകാർ എപ്പോഴും ഉണ്ടാകും. ശമ്പളപരിഷ്കരണം തീർപ്പാക്കിയ ശേഷം, അത്തരം പെൻഷൻകാർക്ക് ശമ്പള കുടിശ്ശിക നൽകുകയും അവരുടെ പെൻഷൻ പരിഷ്കരിക്കുകയും ചെയ്യും. എന്നിരുന്നാലും, ഭൂരിഭാഗം പെൻഷൻകാർക്കും അവരുടെ പുതുക്കിയ പെൻഷൻ പേമെന്റ് ഓർഡർ ലഭിക്കുന്നില്ല. പുതുക്കിയ പെൻഷൻ ലഭിക്കുന്നുണ്ടെങ്കിലും പെൻഷൻ/കുടുംബ പെൻഷൻ ശരിയാണോ എന്ന് പരിശോധിക്കാൻ അവർക്ക് കഴിയുന്നില്ല. പുതുക്കിയ പി പി ഒ ലഭിച്ച സന്ദർഭങ്ങളിൽ മറ്റൊരു സാധാരണ പിശക് കാണുന്നു. ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ കൊടുത്തിരിക്കുന്നത് തെറ്റായിട്ടാണ്. ഇത് പലരുടെയും കാര്വത്തിൽ പിന്നീട് തിരുത്തുകയോ പരിഷ്കരിക്കുകയോ ചെയ്യുന്നില്ല.

#### പെൻഷൻകാരുടെ താൽപര്യം എങ്ങനെ സംരക്ഷിക്കുമെന്ന ചോദ്യമാണ് ഇപ്പോൾ ഉയരുന്നത്.

നിലവിലുള്ള പെൻഷനിൽ എന്തെങ്കിലും മാറ്റം വരുമ്പോൾ അറിയിപ്പുകൾ കൊടുക്കുക എന്നതാണ് പരമ പ്രധാനമായിട്ടുള്ളത്. എന്നാൽ ഇത് എത്രത്തോളം ഫലപ്രദമാകുമെന്ന് കാത്തിരുന്ന് കാണണം. പെൻഷൻകാരുടെ മരണശേഷം, ജീവിതപങ്കാളിക്കോ കുട്ടികൾക്കോ എത്രയാണ് അർഹതപ്പെട്ട ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ എന്ന് ഒരറിവും ഉണ്ടാകില്ല. അതിനാൽ കുറഞ്ഞ തുക പെൻഷൻ ലഭിക്കുമ്പോഴും ആരും ഒന്നും ശ്രദ്ധിക്കാറില്ല. ഈ സാഹചര്വത്തിൽ പെൻഷൻകാരുടെ മരണശേഷം അവരുടെ പ്രിയപ്പെട്ടവർക്ക് എത്ര ഫാമിലി പെൻഷൻ ലഭിക്കും എന്നതിനെക്കുറിച്ചു ഒരു അവബോധം നൽകാൻ എന്റെ ഭാഗത്ത് നിന്ന് ഒരു ശ്രമം നടത്തുകയാണ്.

പാമിലി പെൻഷൻ ഏകദേശ തുകയെക്കുറിച്ച് അവരുടെ പങ്കാളിക്ക് / കുട്ടികൾക്ക് ഒരറിവ് പകർന്നു കൊടുക്കാൻ സാധിച്ചാ ൽ, എന്തെങ്കിലും തെറ്റുകൾ പിന്നീട് കടന്നു കുടിയാ ൽ അതു അവരുടെ കുടുംബാംഗങ്ങളുടെ ശ്രദ്ധയിൽപ്പെടുകയും ചെയ്യും. പ്രായമായ നിരവധി പെൻഷൻകാർ അവരുടെ കുടുംബ പെൻഷൻ എത്രയെന്നു കണക്കുകൂട്ടി പറയാൻ എന്നോടു ആവശ്യപ്പെടുകയുണ്ടായി. അവരുടെ കാലശേഷം അവരുടെ കുടുംബത്തിന് എത്ര പെൻഷൻ ലഭിക്കുമെന്ന് അറിയാൻ സാധിച്ചാൽ അത് മനസ്സമാധാനം നൽകുന്ന കാര്യമാണെന്നതിൽ ഒരു സംശയവുമില്ല.

അത്തരം പെൻഷൻകാർക്ക് അവരുടെ കുടുംബ പെൻഷൻ എത്രയാണെന്ന് മനസ്സിലാക്കാൻ ഈ ലേഖനം സഹായിക്കും.

Umapathi KK, Joint Secretary Alappuzha, Thomas P Mathew, Dist Vice President, Alappuzha, M G Raghavan, President, SBI PAK Kottayam, Jacob PM, Dist Secretary, SBIPAK Kottayam, Mathew Adackamundackal, DGS, SBIPAK, participated.

Shri Koshy Mathew CM (HR) welcomed the participants. He expressed satisfaction for having solved most of the issues raised in the last meeting and assured to follow up the remaining issues. He then invited DGM to address the gathering. In his opening speech DGM expressed his happiness that the Covid has been controlled to an extent as all staff and retirees have been vaccinated. The meeting concluded at 4.55 pm with vote of thanks by CM (HR). From Association side Shri VG Chidambaran proposed vote of thanks.

#### **THIRUVANANTHAPURAM**
